

Small Group Sermon Questions for the week of 2/16/25

2 Corinthians 5:14-21

The questions below are discussion starters based on this week's sermon. Use them to keep your folks engaged with the worship, scripture, and with one another.

- 1) What stood out to you from this week's Scripture and sermon?

- 2) Verses 14-15 talk about Christ dying for all people. Does this mean that all people are saved? How are we saved?

- 3) With 14-15 in mind, how does the sacrificial death of Christ for all people change how we view one another? How does Christ's death change how we regard him? Who is Jesus to you?

- 4) What are some ways we try to change ourselves or become new creations? How is the transformation Christ offers different than what we can do on our own?

- 5) Why is the message of reconciliation so important and who does all the work? What is our proper response to being reconciled to God through Christ?

- 6) Paul says at the end of v20, "Be reconciled to God." How do we do this? Is it possible to be reconciled with God and refuse to be reconciled with one another?

- 7) What does v21 mean?
