2 Corinthians 10

The questions below are discussion starters based on this week's sermon. Use them to keep your folks engaged with the worship, scripture, and with one another.

- 1) What is your default setting when dealing with conflict? Do you tend to seek it out? Do you tend to avoid it? Why?

- 2) Why is it so important that Paul began his confrontation with an appeal by the humility and gentleness of Christ? What was Paul's hope by using this strategy?

- 3) In what ways do we judge people like Paul's enemies were judging him?

- 4) Why did Paul address his opponents? What was at stake?

- 5) How would you describe "strongholds"? What are the weapons available to demolish them?

- 6) What does it mean to capture thoughts and make them obedient to Christ?

- 7) What were your takeaways from this passage and sermon?
